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
Understanding the Honors College Experience Jan 28th, 3 - 4pm, register online

Honors Override and Permission Policy

Honors College Override Policy for *Honors* Students:

The Honors College strives to maintain small class sizes so capacity overrides into Honors sections are rare and only granted to Honors students for compelling reasons. Only the Honors College can grant overrides to Honors College classes (ie professors cannot give permission for Honors student to join a full class). Overrides are considered on a case-by-case basis – Honors students can request consideration for an override by **completing the form on our website**.

*If you receive questions from an Honors student about an override into a full Honors course, please direct them to our website and to contact their Honors advisor.

Honors Override and Permission Policy

For Non-Honors students:

Overrides into *open* Honors sections for non-Honors students are rare and can only be granted by the Honors College. Non-Honors students requesting an override must have a high UofSC GPA (generally 3.65 or above) and typically have demonstrated mastery in the subject matter of the course requested. Non-Honors students can request consideration for Honors permission into a class by **completing the form on our website, which will open a week prior to the start of classes.**

*Students or advisors with questions about this process can contact Ali Mathwig, Director of Advising, but all official requests must be made through the form.

Who can apply?

- Students in their **second** or **third** semester of full-time higher education, who have a minimum 3.6 GPA, and who intend to study at UofSC for five or six additional semesters
- Application available mid-February with an April 15th deadline
